

THOUGHTS FROM THE PASTOR

Healing the Wounds of Abortion

Dear parishioners and friends of Our Lady of the Prairie:

Monday marks the 45th anniversary of the Supreme Court's sinful decision to legalize abortion. I am regularly reminded of this tragedy when I see billboards for hospitals encouraging pregnant women to receive prenatal care for their unborn babies. These advertisements generally include the image of a visibly pregnant woman holding her stomach in a gesture of nurturing. This mother is often accompanied by a 2-3 year old child who seems to be joyfully anticipating the birth of a brother or sister. That one and the same society can have this approach towards encouraging care for an unborn child and legalized abortion at the same time is clear evidence that our culture is deeply wounded and in need of profound healing; healing that only Jesus can provide, one person at a time.

The good news is that Jesus offers this type of healing to the millions of victims of abortion: mothers and fathers who in moments of weakness allowed medical professionals to kill their unborn children. Jesus offers this healing through a Rachel's Vineyard retreat. A Rachel's Vineyard retreat is a prayerful weekend experience that addresses the emotional and spiritual wounds caused by abortion in both women and men. It is a chance for a wounded person to get away from responsibilities so that he or she can attend to the healing that he or she needs in order to have peace and joy. During the Rachel's Vineyard retreat, participants have opportunities to grieve, work on anger, forgive self, and reconcile with God and aborted children.

If you or someone you love has lost a child to abortion I urge you to go on a Rachel's Vineyard retreat. The hurt that accompanies abortion is so very deep and primal that all victims can benefit from receiving help. Until one heals from such a significant loss it will be impossible to experience the fullness of life that Jesus has in store for you. For more information see me, visit
