

THOUGHTS FROM THE PASTOR

Everyone Needs to Forgive Somebody

Dear parishioners and friends of Our Lady of the Prairie:

I went on retreat recently. The retreat was offered by the John Paul II Healing Center, an organization that encourages, teaches, and engages in prayer for healing of emotional, physical, and spiritual maladies. While these dedicated prayer warriors desire that God the Father, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit will use their ministry to heal the suffering in miraculous ways, they are quite clear that forgiveness is a necessary step toward such radical healing, and that if this step is not taken, then healing will be hindered.

I even more recently read Allen R. Hunt's little book, Everyone Needs to Forgive Somebody. By way of 12 short real life stories about forgiveness, Hunt persuades the reader that he or she has someone to forgive and that with God's help, it can be done. Reading Hunt's book convinced me that although I have forgiven in the past, forgiveness is a process, even a lifestyle; a process and lifestyle that I need to continue to practice if I am to become the Christian I desire to be. It is a process and lifestyle we all need to practice if we are to become the parish Jesus is calling us to be.

To that end, I urge you to attend our upcoming Lenten workshop: "Forgiving Our Relationships: Healing Life's Hurts" on Saturday, February 24th. During the workshop, Fr. Matthew Linn, an author and expert on forgiveness, will help us to identify and remove the obstacles that prevent us from receiving and experiencing many of the blessings that Jesus is offering us. He will be with us from 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. with a break for lunch. There is no registration and no fee for the workshop; come for as much of the workshop as you are able. You are welcome to bring your own lunch (refrigerators can be used) or I can arrange to provide you with a simple sandwich and drink from a local establishment for \$5.

As a bonus, I will be giving away copies of Hunt's book, Everyone Needs to Forgive Somebody. I very much hope to see you on Saturday the 24th.




