

THOUGHTS FROM THE PASTOR

Christian Women, Come and See Pietra Fitness

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Our Lady of the Prairie:

Jesus had some major disagreements with people. A number of the people with whom Jesus disagreed were also Jewish, but they understood the Jewish religion differently than Jesus. Some of the people with whom Jesus disagreed belonged to a group called Pharisees. Speaking of the Pharisees on one occasion, Jesus said, "They tie up heavy burdens [hard to carry] and lay them on people's shoulders, but they will not lift a finger to move them" (Matthew 23:4).

Generally speaking, the Pharisees were middle class people of some means who had the money and free time that allowed them to follow Jewish religious laws in a rigorous way that poorer folks were unable to do. The Pharisees seemed to have a devotion to pointing out how poorer non-Pharisees were failing in their religious practice. What upset Jesus was that although the Pharisees were good at pointing out problems, when it came to providing solutions, the Pharisees had few answers.

As you know, I too disagree with a number of people. I believe that the sacraments of the Catholic Church are the normal and efficacious means provided by God for the salvation of every single human being, and that all people would benefit from becoming Catholic and receiving the graces available through the sacraments. For a person to benefit properly from these sacraments, he or she must understand what the human person is, in a thoroughly Christian way. Unfortunately we live in a less than thoroughly Christian culture marked by a syncretism that absorbs and incorporates non-Christian beliefs and normalizes them in such a way that they seem harmless.

This is in fact what has happened with yoga, which originated within and is part of the Hindu religion. As you know, I am opposed to the practice of yoga by Christians, but now I am not only pointing out the yoga problem, I am offering a solution: Pietra Fitness.

Dear PREP parents:

Though I know there have been challenges, I hope that you and your children have benefited from our Family Faith Formation program. I would like to give you some objective criteria by which to evaluate your work of raising your children in the Catholic Faith; please trust what I have to say as it is both my expertise and responsibility. If you provide a good example to your children by bringing them with you to Confession regularly (ideally monthly), attend Mass with them every Sunday (or Saturday evening), and pray with them every day, then you are doing your part. Yes, we can always do any and all of these better, and that is something for which you are encouraged to strive, but if you do these three things: monthly Confession, weekly Mass, and daily prayer, and encouraging and supporting them in your children, you are doing well.

Please keep these practices up during the summer; they are essential.


