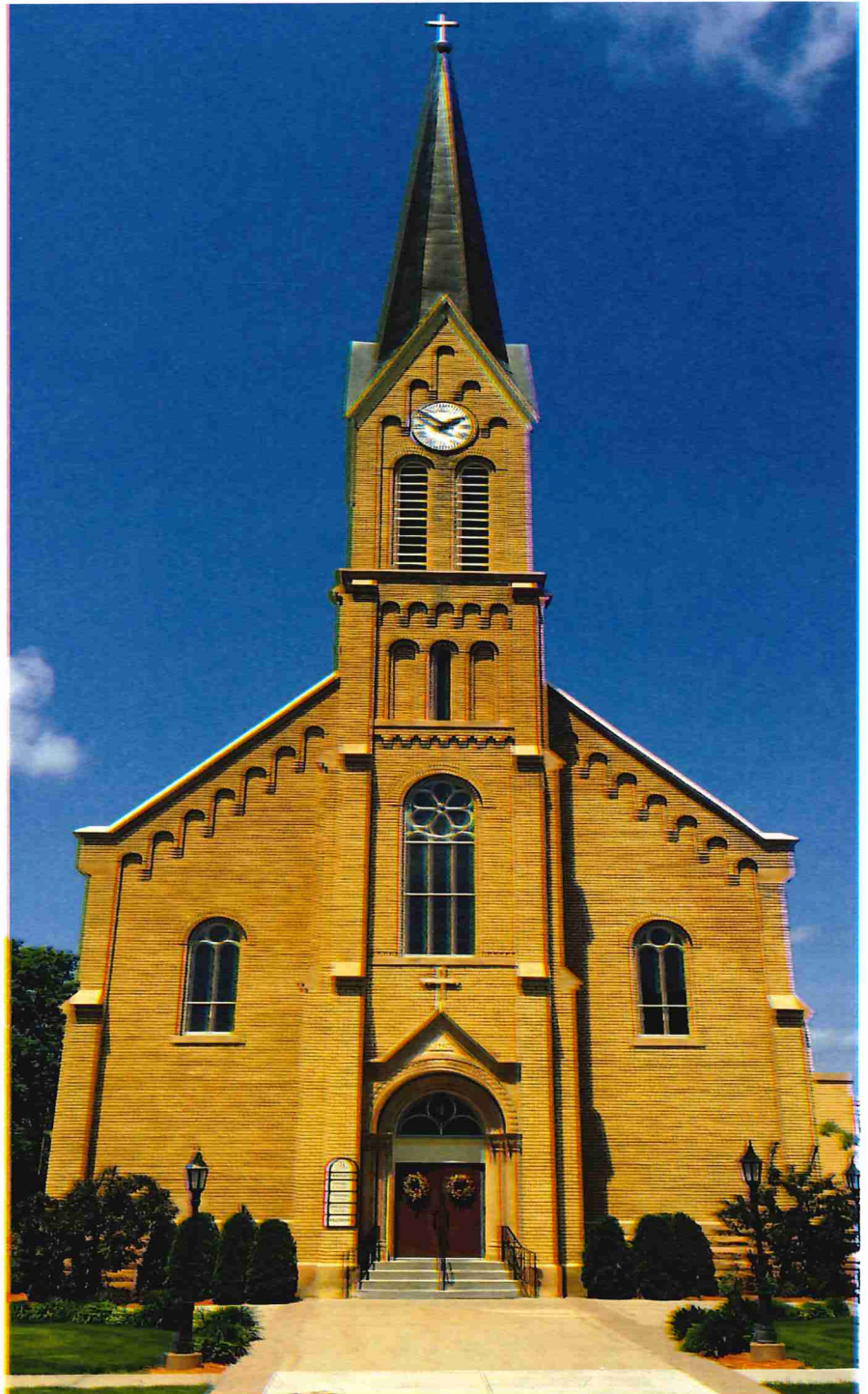

THOUGHTS FROM THE PASTOR**Catholic Identity**

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Our Lady of the Prairie:

Recently I attended a gathering of Catholic folks from Latin America living in the Twin Cities area. I talked with a woman from Mexico who has lived in Minnesota for about one year and who sends her children to her parish school. She spoke of the need she and her family have to believe in something and belong to something. Her concern was that if she allowed her children to drift along with the prevailing American culture, in time her children would not believe in anything.

This Catholic mother has it exactly right. Perhaps the relative difficulty with which she as a Mexican woman can blend into her adopted community makes it easier for her than it is for you or I to experience and articulate the threat to her family's beliefs and values. Whatever the reason for her insights we should recognize it to be true for all of us and take steps to safeguard our own beliefs and values and those of our young people. This is done by establishing a truly Catholic personal identity for ourselves and nurturing and protecting Catholic identity in our young people.

The absolute foundation of a Catholic identity is living the sacramental life of the Church by participating in Mass every Sunday and going to Confession regularly. To help you accomplish this we offer 4 Sunday Masses weekly: 4:15 p.m. Saturday and 8 a.m., 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Sunday. Confessions are offered regularly at a variety of times and for several hours on the First Friday of the month.

In addition to the sacraments, a Catholic identity is strengthened through daily prayer. Regularly praying with other family members is a great way to support and encourage one another in having Catholic identities.

For those of you with school aged children, a terrific way to support and strengthen Catholic identity is by sending your children to Catholic school. I would be delighted to speak with any and all of you about the possibility of having your children at our parish school. It is quite possible you have preconceived ideas that make it difficult for you to choose a Catholic education for your children; I can help you with those concerns, but I cannot help unless we have a conversation.

Please live your Catholic identity and foster it in our young people!
