

THOUGHTS FROM THE PASTOR

First Saturday and Change

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Our Lady of the Prairie:

For the last couple years I have felt that for my own well being and that of the parish I should eliminate our 8:30 a.m. First Saturday Mass, and so I have done that. Allow me to

explain.

One of the aspects of Catholic Church life that I consider unwise is the redundancy in our offerings for Mass. This sentiment was cemented in me during a previous assignment in which we offered seven Sunday Masses at two different locations. Although two of these Masses had qualities that made them distinct, the other five were quite similar. Not only that, there was another parish less than three miles away that offered three more Sunday Masses that would have met the needs of most people, and the total number of people attending all Sunday Masses only warranted about five of these 10 Masses. The problem as I see it is that the Church puts a great deal of its resources into replicating good-enough nearly indistinguishable Masses for the sake of convenience rather than putting those same resources of time, energy, and talent into fewer but more excellent or unique offerings.

And so it has been the case with the First Saturday 8:30 a.m. morning Mass at Our Lady of the Prairie. Attendance has been poor and some of those who have attended also attended the Saturday evening Mass at 4:15 p.m. It is also the case that both St. John the Baptist in Jordan and St. Anne in Le Sueur offer First Saturday morning Masses, so anyone in Belle Plaine who needs a First Saturday morning Mass should be able

to attend one without too much difficulty.

Another factor is the number of Masses I am able to say during any one day. On Saturday I have a limit of two Masses and on Sunday a limit of three. Two Masses scheduled on the first Saturday of the month makes it difficult for me to schedule a funeral Mass or a wedding Mass for those days. The two regularly scheduled Masses on First Saturday also make it difficult for me to help one of my brother priests in one of our neighboring parishes (Union Hill, Cologne, or Carver for example) with their Saturday evening "Farmer's Mass" in the 7 - 9 p.m. time frame.

It is also the case that I have been providing some unique offerings for Scott County and the surrounding area, including Confessions on Wednesday mornings at 6 a.m. and First Fridays from 3 p.m. until 8 p.m. and a 6 p.m. Sunday evening Mass. All of this takes time and energy, and I need to have periods of time that allow me to attend to personal needs, such as spending time with priest friends, and preparing for

preaching at Mass and other events.

I hope you can understand and accept this change. If it has been your custom to attend Mass on First Saturday morning at OLP, please continue to attend Mass on First Saturdays, whether our 4:15 p.m. Mass or the 8:15 a.m. Mass at St. John the Baptist in Jordan or 8 a.m. at St. Anne's in Le Sueur.
