

THOUGHTS FROM THE PASTOR

Summer

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Our Lady of the Prairie:

By the time you read this column both BBQ Days and the Major League Baseball All-Star Game will have come and gone, and with them the first half of summer. This is significant because for many of us summer is the season during which it is relatively easily to take a break from daily routines to enjoy some rest and relaxation. If this is the case for you, and you were not able to take a break during the first half of the summer, be sure to make it a priority during the second half.

I know that such breaks are significant for me. When I take a break from my regular routines by getting out of them I am able to evaluate those routines and make decisions about whether or not to continue them. An old fashioned retreat is a great setting in which to do such an evaluation, but in my experience it can also be done during some quiet time while on vacation.

For many of us, calendars get crowded after Labor Day, and the daily schedule we set for the Thursday after Labor Day will be repeated nearly each and every week until Thanksgiving. Something similar could be said about the other days of the week. Rather than uncritically replicating the calendars we kept last year, please be sure to consider how well last year's calendar worked for you and your family, especially with regard to religion.

Especially significant days for religious practice are Fridays, the day we recall Christ's passion and death, and Sundays when we celebrate the Resurrection at Mass. If you have had trouble identifying a time to do religious devotions or study, whether as an individual or a family, please consider dedicating some of your Friday evening to religion. As you may know, I have set aside 3 pm - 8 pm on the First Friday of each month as a time for devotions at the church, including Confession and Stations of the Cross. On Sundays, please keep in mind that we have 4 Masses at which you can fulfill your obligation, including 6pm on Sunday. The 6 pm Sunday Mass is intended to help those who find it difficult to attend Mass on Sunday morning whether because of travel or other reasons. Please take time to identify a regular Mass time that will work well for you and your family this fall and put it in your calendar before summer ends.
