

THOUGHTS FROM THE PASTOR

The State of Grace and our Need for the Sacraments

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Our Lady of the Prairie:

Last weekend I mentioned that the reason we attend Mass every weekend is because we want to live forever. Unfortunately this is not understood by people as it was just 60 years ago. Many, many people have been deceived into thinking that nearly everyone who dies goes to Heaven automatically. This is not the case. Be sure of this: no one goes to Heaven automatically. As St. Paul said in his Letter to the Romans, "all have sinned and are deprived of the glory of God." If any of us does go to Heaven, it will be because of Jesus.

At the moment of death each and every human being, whether Catholic, atheist or otherwise, will be judged by Jesus himself. At that particular judgement, Jesus will reveal to the deceased in which of just two possible states he or she has died: the state of grace or the state of unrepented mortal sin. Those who die in the state of grace will receive Jesus' gift of eternal life in Heaven. Those who die in the state of unrepented mortal sin are not capable of receiving the gift of eternal life and are destined for Hell.

As a consequence, your #1 responsibility in life, even more significant than your responsibility to be "happy" or "nice" or "successful" or "healthy" is to remain in the state of grace. Unfortunately, it is easier to live in a state of unrepented mortal sin than it is to live in the state of grace.

Jesus put you in the state of grace through the Sacrament of Baptism which freed you from the guilt of original sin. Once a person is baptized, Jesus uses the Mass and Confession to keep you in the state of grace and return you to the state of grace. By attending satisfy Sunday Mass you responsibility to worship Jesus in the way he commanded; to fail to do so without being excused because of poor health is a grave evil, and those who fail to attend Sunday Mass even during the summer should assume they are in the state of mortal sin by this grave omission. If you do miss Sunday Mass without being excused, and decide you want to go to Heaven rather than Hell, you should make a good Confession as soon as reasonably possible. By way of a good Confession, Jesus will return you to the state of grace.
