

#### HOW TO KICK START YOUR FAITH AT COLLEGE

As some of our young adults begin their first year in college this year, as parents we always worry about them in more ways than one. How much will they change in their lifestyles, whether it is for the better or not for the better. Yes, we as parents always pray for them, but it is up to them to make their own choices. We may worry about them keeping their faith. We should be encouraged to help them prioritize about keeping their faith. I'd like to share from an article about 9 ways to kick start your faith at college.

1) Begin and end with prayer. There are some college students who are not at their best in the morning, but begin with a short prayer by saying: "thank you God for waking me up this morning." If you wish you could Google "examen" because all the top hits are helpful. At the end of the day, just say, "thank you God for helping me in getting through today."

2) Frequent the sacraments. There are many things that will change in your life at college, like how you spend your time, what and who you will get to know and what to join. Go to Mass at least every Sunday and once or twice during the week. Regularly try to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation, by putting a date on your calendar to do so. Receive the Eucharist often.

3) Keep holy the Sabbath. Not only going to Mass each Sunday, but refraining from doing unnecessary work on Sunday. Maybe just spending a little extra time in prayer.

4) Mend broken relationships. Ask for forgiveness from those you have hurt in your past life. Sometimes this is a very hard thing to do.

5) Minimize your "stuff." Don't take everything with you for

your dorm. Having space gives you room to grow.

6) Plan to keep in touch. You cannot keep in touch with all your high school friends, but only with those who are very important to you. Don't forget to communicate with Mom and Dad on a regular basis.

7)Read for pleasure. Try and choose one book that you will read during the 1st semester that is not for a class. Pick just one

book only so you don't overwhelm yourself.

8) Seek out a Spiritual Director and Faith Community. A Spiritual Director is a master of discipline who is trained to help you to develop your faith. So, how do you find a Spiritual Director? If there is a Catholic student center, Newman Center, or campus ministry at your college, get in touch with them, and tell them you are looking for a Spiritual Director.

9) Reassess often. Being proactive rather than reactive is the key. Those who enter into a mature faith prioritize their faith. Don't put pressure on yourself to do everything right immediately. You won't. So after the end of the first semester, assess how your first semester went. Think back on what you have accomplished and what you must do to do better in the

future.

May God and the Holy Spirit guide you in your decisions as you begin your next stage of life.


#### **Donations**


If you don't have the time or resources to create a basket you can donate a single item and we will pair it to make the perfect basket for the Silent-Auction.


