

### THOUGHTS FROM OUR PASTOR

### Spiritual Reading is Essential to Christian Life

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Our Lady of the Prairie:

I'm writing this bulletin column on July 31, the day on which the Universal Church remembers St. Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Society of Jesus, also called the Jesuits. Ignatius lived in Spain during the Protestant "Reformation." As a young soldier, like St. Francis of Assisi 300 years prior, Ignatius was injured in battle, and during the many weeks of his bedridden recovery, he had lots and lots of time on his hands. Without the convenient contemporary distractions of radio, television, computer or telephone, Ignatius had books. Though attracted to stories about heroic knights and their romantic interests, because of their availability, Ignatius eventually found himself reading books about Jesus and the lives of the saints. He noticed that unlike books about knights and their ladies, religious stories had a positive enduring influence on him. This became a significant experience in his life, one that guided him as he helped others to make better choices that would help them to become better friends with Jesus and his friends, the saints.

Despite it becoming less and less popular, reading is crucial for human beings to reach their intellectual and spiritual potential; the very Word of God is something that is read. While we can benefit from reading scripture regularly (even daily), there are many other significant Christian writings, ancient and modern, that can help us to become better friends of Jesus.

Certain times and seasons are traditionally considered more suited for reading, and summer is considered one of those seasons when people take time to relax on vacation. In Minnesota, winter (especially January - March) is another season that lends itself to reading, as the weather makes a number of outdoor activities unattractive, unpleasant, or even dangerous.

Please challenge yourself to do some spiritual reading before summer ends. If you start with the Bible, consider beginning with the Gospel of Mark rather than page 1. Next week I hope to offer a number of books from which you can choose. If spiritual reading is not already a familiar and regular practice, I hope that it will soon become one for you and your family.
