## A MESSAGE FROM DEACON MIKE



### Ordinary Time... Is A Time to Stir Up Our Faith

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Our Lady of the Prairie,

The decorations and lights have been put away for another year as we quietly exit the Christmas season and once again enter Ordinary Time.

Ordinary Time is, for Catholics, the opportunity to allow the Lord to stir up our faith, to allow our spirits to rise and to grow in our spiritual life. The color green brings this meaning to the fore, since it is a color that evokes life and growth.

Ordinary Time is called "ordinary" not because it is common but simply because the weeks of Ordinary Time are numbered. The Latin word *ordinalis*, which refers to numbers in a series, stems from the Latin word *ordo*, from which we get the English word *order*. Thus, the numbered weeks of Ordinary Time, represent the ordered life of the Church – the period in which we live our lives neither in feasting (as in Christmas and Easter seasons) or in more severe penance (as in Advent and Lent), but in watchfulness and expectation of the Second Coming of Christ.

It's appropriate that the Gospel for the Second Sunday of Ordinary Time (which is actually the first Sunday celebrated in Ordinary Time) always features either John the Baptist's acknowledgement of Christ as the Lamb of God or Christ's first miracle – the transformation of water into wine at the wedding at Cana. Thus, for Catholics, Ordinary Time is the part of the year in which Christ, the Lamb of God, walks among us and transforms our lives. There's nothing ordinary about that!

As we journey through Ordinary Time towards the Lenten season, I pray your heart is open to the movements of the Holy Spirit. Building a relationship with the Lord begins with placing your trust in Him and believing in His saving power. Jesus desires that relationship with you because you are loved by Him...always and forever.
