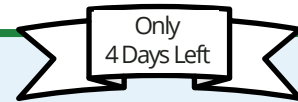
Exciting News! Due to your generosity, statue painting has begun, and church painting is scheduled to begin in July. Scaffolding will be up for approximately 3 months.
