

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER MICHAEL . . .

The readings this weekend speak to us about wisdom. That's something all of us need! As we grow in our faith, we also grow in wisdom. To be near and close to God is the wisest choice we can make so that we might readily know God in this world and be happy with God forever in the life to come.



The psalm sings about loving God's commands. The commandments are given to us for our own good and pleasure. God does not tell us to choose evil and desires our own happiness. That's why the commandments are an essential aid. The commandments are not to be understood as punishments; rather they help us as guides to holiness and happiness. God does not force us into anything, but offers us free will. It delights God for us to freely choose God's ways and that gives glory to God.

Jesus tells us in the Gospel that the Kingdom of Heaven is a real treasure. A disciple is one who seeks that treasure and gives up everything to obtain that grace. It takes wisdom to find that path that leads to the treasure!

In the first reading, King Solomon asks for an understanding heart to follow God's direction. He desires to lead the people in the ways of God and to be open to receiving direction and instruction from God. God's love is rooted in a generous heart and God provides the capacity for each one of us. May we also make this same request of God so that we may be led by God into the embrace of eternity!
