

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER MICHAEL . . .

Be Not Afraid

Jesus invites Peter to come out and walk on the water. In doing so he also invites us, the church, to do the impossible and cultivate the faith that makes all things possible. Our faith is possible because of the invitation from God. Jesus was sent from God to show us the way, the truth and the



life. As members of the Body of Christ, the church, we are moved by faith to respond to the invitation of Jesus.

When Peter responds to the invitation from God to keep his gaze fixed on Christ, Peter is able to walk on water. When he glances away, he experiences trouble. Our spiritual life is much the same. We need to keep our eyes securely focused on Jesus, because he is all things to us.

In the first reading Elijah finds God in the whispering voice, even though he sought God in the strong and powerful elements of nature. Sometimes God surprises us and reminds us that God is always faithful and we have to trust that God is indeed always there when we seek him.

One of the early symbols for the church was a boat. The church was seen as a small boat tossed around in an unfriendly sea (a world that persecuted Christians). But the presence of Jesus in the boat calms the storm, and keeps the voyagers safe. Jesus continues to calm storms. He still reaches out and pulls us up when we call out and put our trust in him. Fear can seize us without warning, but we will be better prepared for it if we follow Jesus' example.

We can take comfort in knowing that we are not to be afraid to face the future and that God will be with us as we endeavor to continue the mission of the church. May the Holy Spirit breathe the gifts of wisdom and courage into our parish community to make prudent decisions for our sake and the sake of the whole world!
