



Dear Rural Resident of Deanery 7,

I am a member of an Archdiocesan Care for Creation task force formed specifically to listen to your issues and concerns. The listening sessions held as part of the Synod process gave a voice to many parishioners throughout the archdiocese, but members of the task force are interested in what YOU have to say about your life in a rural area of the archdiocese.

I belong to St. Wenceslaus parish in New Prague. I served the parish for 28 years as a Catholic school teacher, pastoral minister and in faith formation with youth and adults. I am a secular Franciscan and am involved in care for creation and serving families experiencing homelessness. I grew up on a dairy farm in rural Jordan and currently live on the farm with my husband.

The listening sessions will be held in New Prague on Thursday, August 3 and Monday, August 7, from 7-9pm in the St. Wenceslaus Parish Activities Center (only attend one).
