



### A MESSAGE FROM FATHER MICHAEL . . .

Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

Every church year concludes with the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, which highlights a central truth within our deposit of faith: Jesus Christ is the universal king and judge of all. Our readings this week focus on the kingship of Jesus and our need to




recognize that royalty in our lives. It is a kingship that offers salvation for those who acknowledge his might and majesty.


