

The Third Sunday of Advent is traditionally called "Gaudete Sunday", which is Latin for "rejoice!" There is great joy in our Advent preparation. We anticipate something spectacular and realize that it calls for us to be ready.



God. Jesus has shared that joy with us in doing the work he began in his ministry. Mercy and justice are the work of God and we have been invited to share in those divine labors!

Saint Paul writes to the Thessalonians in the Second Reading to rejoice always and our lighting of the rose-colored candle reminds us to rejoice during this holy season of preparation and waiting!

We are told in the Gospel about Saint John the Baptist's testimony to the light. Jesus is the light of the world and the light of our eyes. During these days of darkness, the lighting of the Advent wreath reminds us of Jesus first coming and his return to find us joyful in recognizing his presence in the world and sharing that Good News!

Next weekend we will celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Advent as well as Christmas Eve and Christmas Day on Monday, December 25th. As Catholics we must attend Mass for each celebration. Archbishop Hebda has reminded us that there is no "two for one" possibility. Therefore, Fourth Sunday of Advent Masses are celebrated on Saturday evening and Sunday morning. We will celebrate Christmas Eve Masses on Sunday at 3 p.m. and 4:15 p.m. and Christmas Day Masses are at 8 a.m. and 10 a.m.
