A MESSAGE FROM FATHER MICHAEL . . .

The Power of God and Our Response

In the first reading at Mass we hear about King David wanting to do something great for God. He wants to build a temple for the Most High God to dwell. Yet he learns through the prophet Nathan that it is in fact God who does great things for us! As we mature in our spiritual lives, this becomes



the great lesson that God indeed turns everything upside down. Our humanity gets in the way of us recognizing our existence before the creator. Rather, God is the one who takes the initiative to accompany his family wherever they go. God's kingdom endures forever and God is the one who allows humanity to respond to God's invitation to be friends. This is a mighty and powerful lesson that we continue to learn time and time again. It is repeated in Scripture and experienced in our faith life.

In the Gospel, Mary understands that God's power is at work. She recognizes that without God, she cannot do anything. But with the help of God, she can accomplish great things. She freely receives the blessings that God has bestowed upon her and makes a response of faith. We recognize her trust and hold her as a great model for all of us to make a similar response of trust and faith in the great things that God allows to happen in our lives.

We think that we do God a favor by coming to Mass, when in fact we need to learn that it is God who does us a great favor by allowing us to come to Mass. It is God who planted the seed of faith in our hearts and gave us the gift of free will. It is God who sent his Son to be our friend and redeemer to heal us and restore us to become sons and daughters. God initiates a great plan for our salvation and invites us to make a response. As Mary teaches us, what seems impossible is always possible for God. Therefore, our response to God's blessing is in fact a gift that God gives to us.

As we conclude Advent, let us consider how God has powerfully worked in our lives and how our preparation this season is a response to the love that God bestowed upon us. In our parish we recognize all the blessings that we have received. In recognition of those blessings, may we be ready to welcome the Christ child as the one who makes all things possible!

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,


Merry Christmas to you and to your loved ones! Please know of my prayers for each of you as we celebrate the birth of Jesus our Savior and the true Light.
