
Sacrament of Baptism

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER MICHAEL . . .

Jesus announces in the Gospel: "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the Gospel." At the dawn of a new year and early in the season of ordinary time, we are faced with the challenge of the Gospel – to repent and believe. These commands of the Lord are not only meant for times when



even secular society tells us to be in church, for example Christmas and Easter, but for each and every day of our lives. And these commands are challenging, because so often and so easily we can move away from God and the Church. Yet, this is how Jesus inaugurates the Church and begins his ministry by calling disciples.

We are called by God and God awaits our response to his invitation. The readings this week help us to focus on what matters most and that might help us to make a conscious response to the summons of Jesus.

In the first reading we are reminded of God's generous mercy. Being moved by the repentance of the people of Nineveh, God relented of his punishment, because the people changed their evil ways. As members of the Church, we too must be willing to change our ways and direct our focus as to what it means to be disciples – even willing to leave all to follow Jesus. When we announce this with our words and actions, we demonstrate our own commitment to be ever present to the Lord.

In order to assist us with this task, Psalm 25 reminds us that we need heavenly guidance. The Church helps us with her teaching magisterium to be authentic disciples and to follow Jesus. When we listen carefully to the instruction of the Church, we educate ourselves in the ways of truth and righteousness. Often these lessons are in conflict with the ways of world and when that becomes apparent, we must speak out. As disciples, we must work to educate the world of God's ways so that we might truly repent and believe in the Gospel.


