

#### A MESSAGE FROM FATHER MICHAEL . . .

The Gift of Salvation

In the Gospel, Saint Matthew tells us that the magi came from far away revealing to us the visiting kings were foreigners. They came to a strange land because they were prompted by their heart to receive something that was so great



– a Messiah not only for the Jewish people, but even for those who are from a far distant land. Saint Matthew gives us the message that God intended to offer salvation to all people, Jews and gentiles alike. Saint Paul repeats that theme in the second reading calling the gentiles "coheirs". That is the great gift of the Messiah – God wants to redeem sinful humanity and have them be reconciled. The mission of the Son is to be faithful to the will of the Father in restoring humanity and becoming a gift to the Father and offering us an example to follow.

That gift of salvation is continually offered by our loving God for those who respond to the promptings of the Spirit. The Holy Spirit moves us to worship God, just as the Holy Spirit prompted the magi to visit the child Jesus. The Gospel reminds us of the great joy experienced by the magi and how they prostrated themselves to do him homage. That great joy is a gift offered to us as well when we seek the Messiah.

We too can come to visit our King and do him homage in church. At Mass and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, we present ourselves to the Lord of Lords and King of Kings. Jesus waits for us to make a visit. In return for that visit, God freely bestows the gift of salvation upon us who desire to be in relationship with him. That relationship blossoms in the gift of prayer as a means of continually carrying on that relationship with Jesus. During the season of Christmas, may our prayer always be fruitful, and may we be receptive to receiving the great gift of salvation through Jesus Christ!

### Testimony and Gratitude for Our Lady of the Prairie Catholic School

We were introduced to Catholic education through a friend at the beginning of COVID. We weren't



happy with aspects of the public schools. Had COVID not happened I don't know if we would have made the switch. There was a silver lining.

Our oldest was the first to attend Holy Cross Catholic school as a 7th grader. We were extremely nervous about our decision. She went from several hundred kids in her grade to ten. They didn't have some of the amenities that the public school offered. How would she adjust? Having never experienced small setting private education, we had only assumptions. And you have to pay for it! Boy, all negative reservations quickly dissolved. I cannot believe what we were missing. I can't stress that enough.

Faith based education in a smaller setting outperformed any and all of our expectations. The following year our second youngest started preschool at Holy Cross with our now 8th grade daughter. She was able to sit with him during Mass. Often the older kids would play with their younger siblings and classmates during recess. Sometimes sitting with them at lunch to make sure they finished their food. God's plan usually is beyond our comprehension and this was another example. My daughter's religious education soon surpassed ours and we found ourselves diving deeper into our faith.

The quality of the staff and especially the students and families was something I wasn't prepared for. Our only regret was not starting sooner.

When we moved back to Belle Plaine, it was a no brainer. We have been so happy to have our second youngest at OLP. He loves the staff and his classmates and is thriving. It's such a blessing. Our oldest is attending public school and is adjusting well. She is equipped with tools to handle the ups and downs of high school life she didn't have before. You truly do not know what you are missing. The financial aspect is a small sacrifice. I have spent a lot more on much more foolish things. We are so blessed to have this school in our town.






