A MESSAGE FROM FATHER MICHAEL . . .

Laetare Sunday

This Sunday we read one of the most famous and often quoted passages from the Gospels: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish, but might have eternal life" (John 3:16). This quote is not only for football games, but rather for



all people in all places in all times. That is the heart of the Gospel – God's abundant and generous love in the gift of Jesus.

We rejoice this Sunday as we reach the half-way point of Lent – a season of grace that readies us for the celebration of the Easter season. It is a good time to review our practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Have we been generous in preparing for Easter? It is never too late and we still have weeks to go. This might be the time that we need to encounter the mercy of God in the celebration of reconciliation and renew our commitment to the recommended disciplines.

As we pray, we recall the great gift of Jesus to the world and grow in our encounter with his living presence in our lives. We remember that prayer is a two-way conversation between ourselves and God, so we must also listen. As we fast, we long more worthily for his presence. In our hunger, we desire to be satisfied with an ever-more awareness of God working in our lives. And as we share our treasure, we realize how blessed we have been. It is in giving that we receive and giving alms helps us to understand that God is creator and giver. We partake in the goodness of God as we serve others.

Nicodemus visits Jesus in the darkness of night and Jesus tells him that the Son of Man must be lifted up to be a light to the world. In offering all that he has and making his life a gift to the world, he shows us the way to the eternal life. Has the light of Jesus illuminated the path that we choose to walk so that we might be ready for life in eternity?


