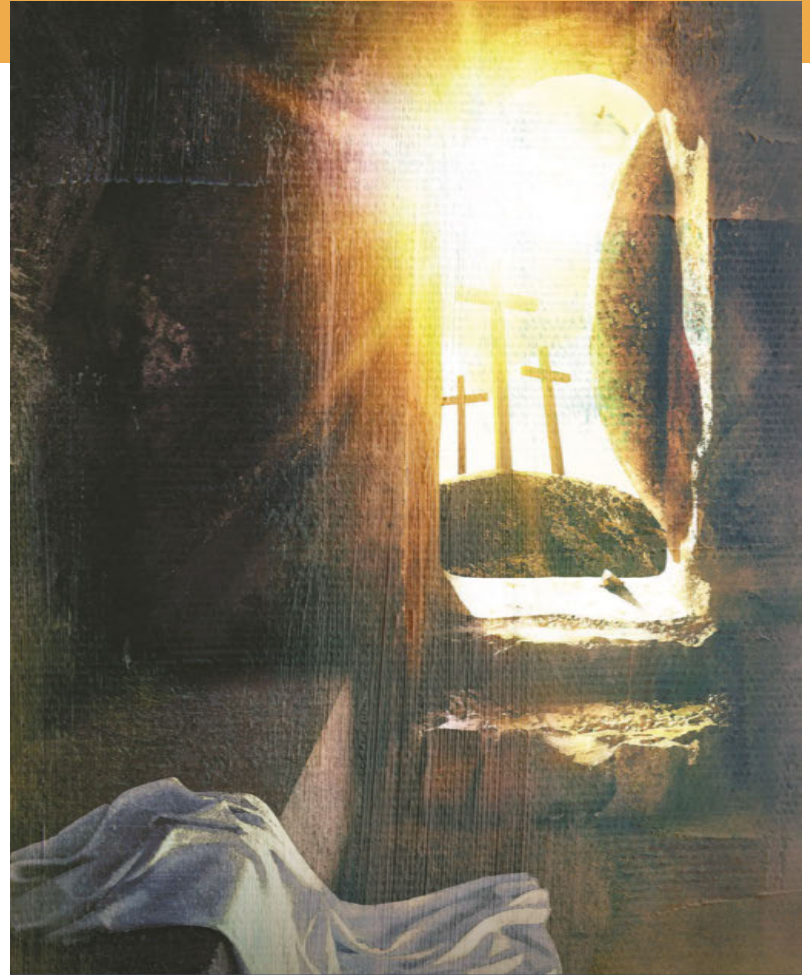

Alleluia the tomb is vacant! The empty tomb changes everything! That the tomb is empty is God's way of telling us that we are loved. God's love emptied the tomb and rose from the dead. 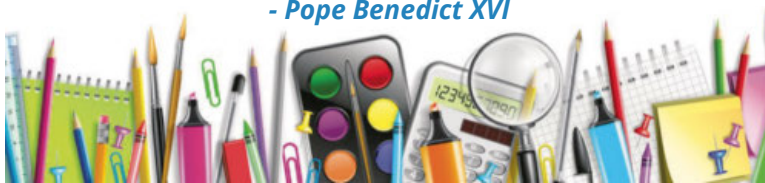

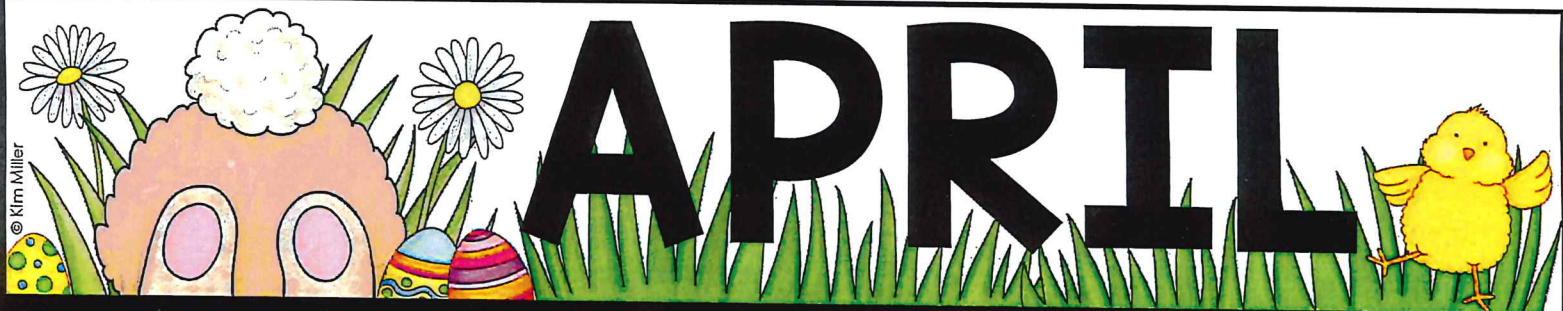

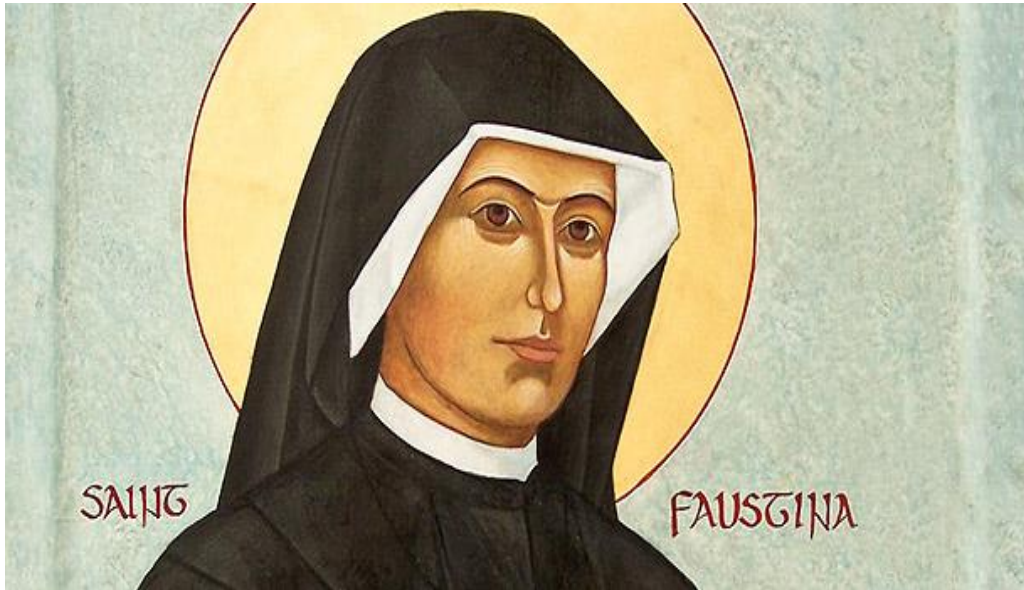
