

Divine Mercy Sunday

We mark the Eighth Day of Easter with the great privilege of celebrating Divine Mercy Sunday! Since the year 2000 the Church has officially recognized the Second Sunday of Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday. The Scriptures offer many ways for



us to enter into the mystery of God's great gift to us who find ourselves in great need of mercy.

The first reading from the Acts of the Apostles reminds us of that the disciples built a community sharing life together. Their model continues to be the ultimate example for Christian communities. In sharing a common life, they continued the mission instituted by our Lord. Prayer is at the heart of any Christian community and growing closer to God and one another through prayer allows each member to feel connected and remain committed. They also bear witness to caring for the needs of others as a sign of what it means to be Christian.

The Gospel shows Jesus giving power to his disciples to continue to carry on the mission and speaks of God's mercy in the forgiveness of sins. Jesus gave Thomas all that he needed to believe and that is the gift of the risen Christ! May we too come to practice our faith as active Christians because we have been given all that we need to truly practice what has been handed on to us!
