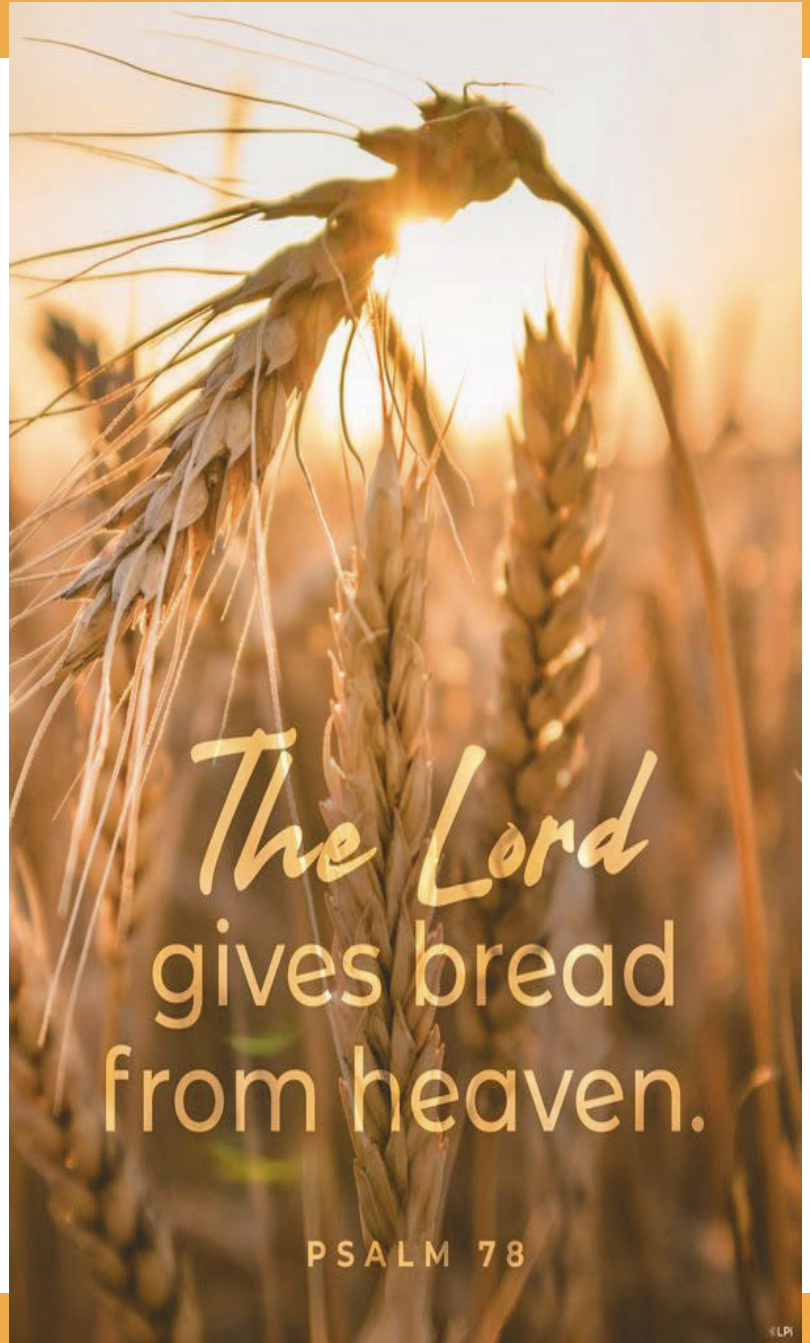

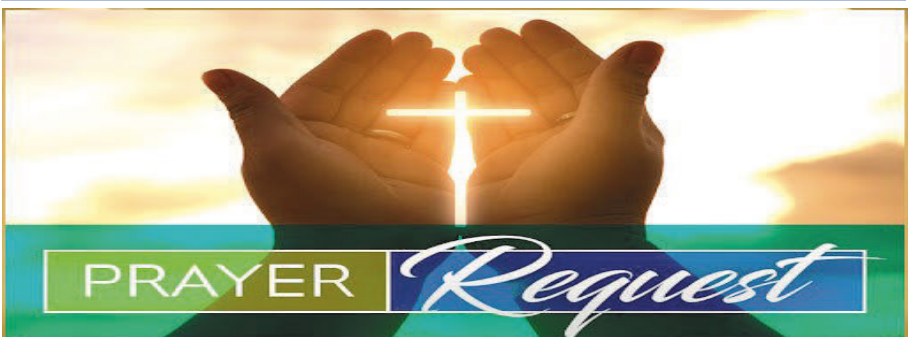
Our parish community is a treasure. May we safeguard our gift and share God's love.
