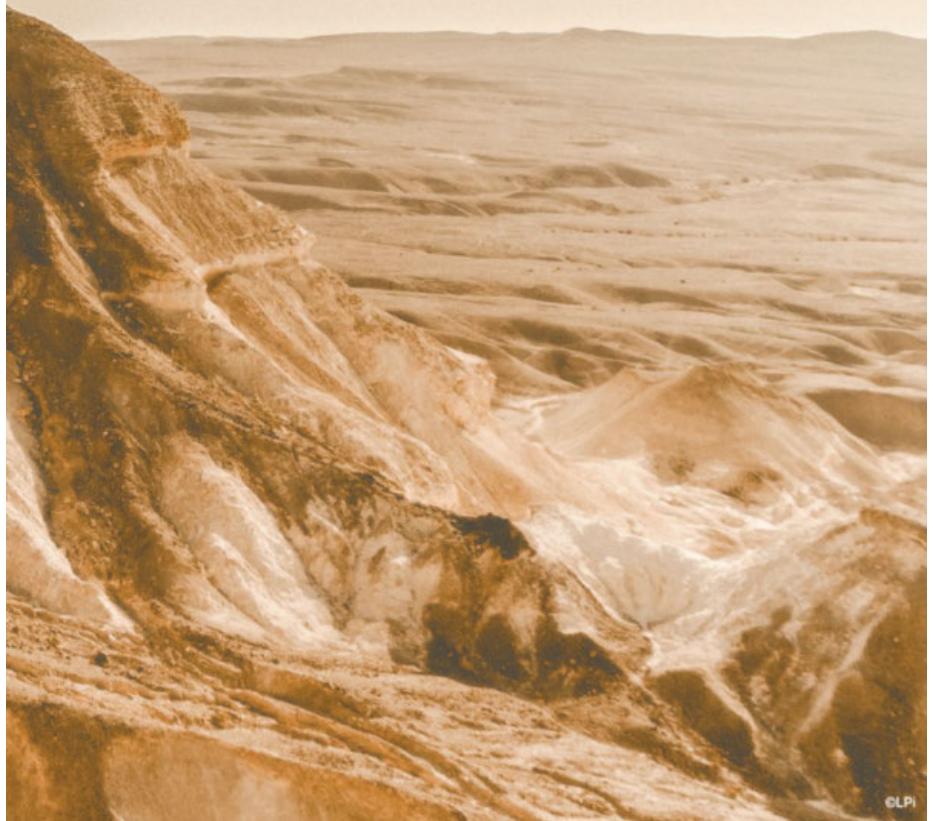

## A MESSAGE FROM FATHER MICHAEL . . .

As Lent begins the time has come to commit to making resolutions and changes in our lives. In the beginning it seems easy to give up something we like, or take on extra time for prayer, or add additional commitments, but after a while, it becomes more of a challenge. We might have already experienced this after only a few days of Lent. Our Christian heritage recalls the challenges of our faith and how we have grown spiritually from the trials of life and practice of our faith.

The scripture readings focus on the spiritual theme of remembering. We remember our ancestors in faith always made an offering for first fruits a priority. God elected them and they made a response in gratitude. The first reading is also a remembrance of creed - recalling what God in his might and majesty has done. We also recall how our Lord was tempted and how he willingly faced temptation for our sake. We often find ourselves tempted by things that lead us away from God and can take the example of Jesus. Jesus remembers who he is and recalls the words of Scripture that affirm his commitment to the mission of the Father.

During Lent I hope all of you will stay near and close to the church. Please attend Stations of the Cross on Fridays. This long-revered devotion of our faith is a traditional Friday practice. Stations are offered two times each Friday at 9 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. Be sure to join us.
