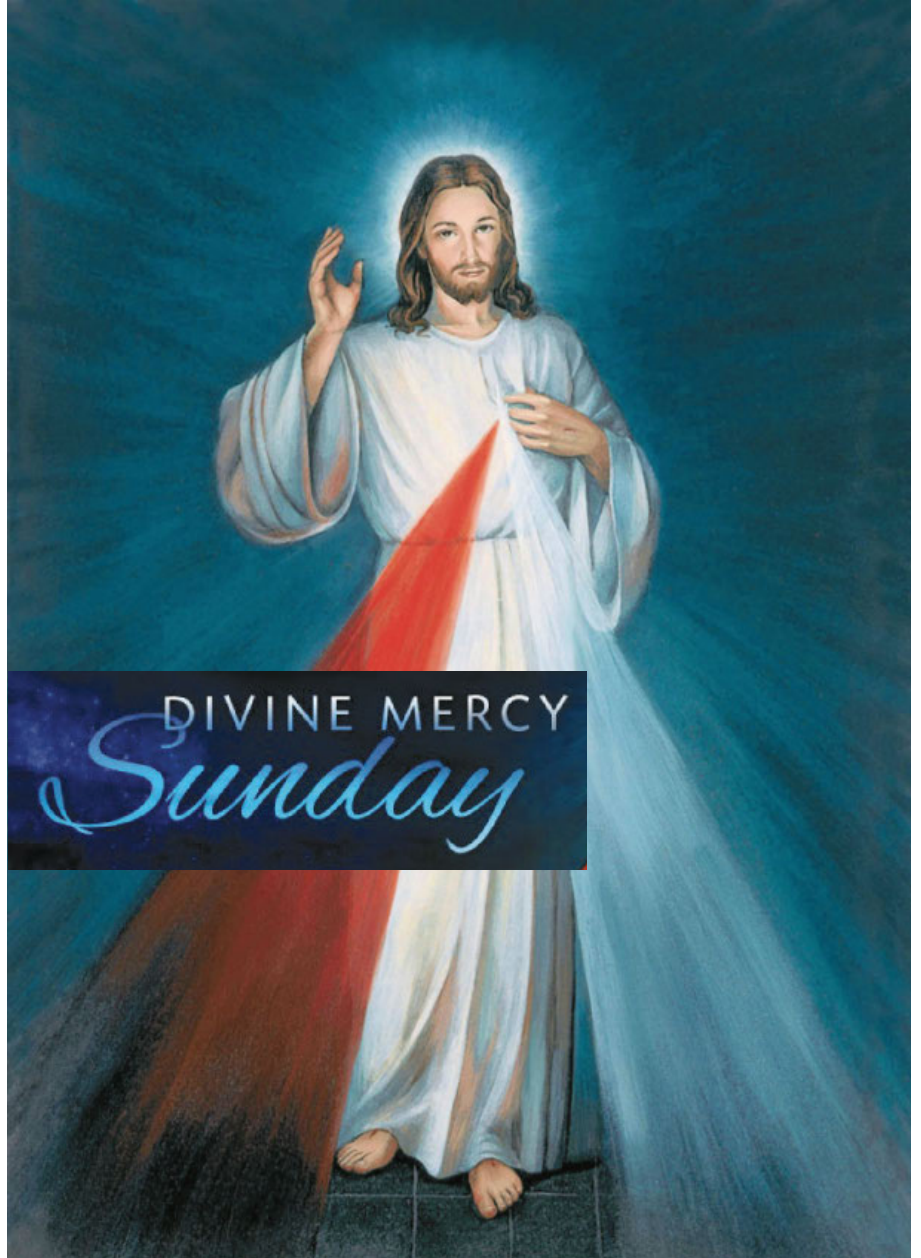

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER MICHAEL . . .

Divine Mercy Sunday

The miracle of Easter is all about transformation! We are transformed by God's continuous outpouring of love. His love is strong enough to endure the passion and death on a cross. That example of complete giving is meant to motivate us to transform our lives imitate the selfless love that Jesus has shown the world.



Divine Mercy Sunday recognizes the abundant mercy of God offers to us through Christ. Our faith is built upon the resurrection of Jesus and that is indeed a miracle of mercy. Divine Mercy Sunday is a reminder that the love of God is much stronger than the bonds of sin and death.
