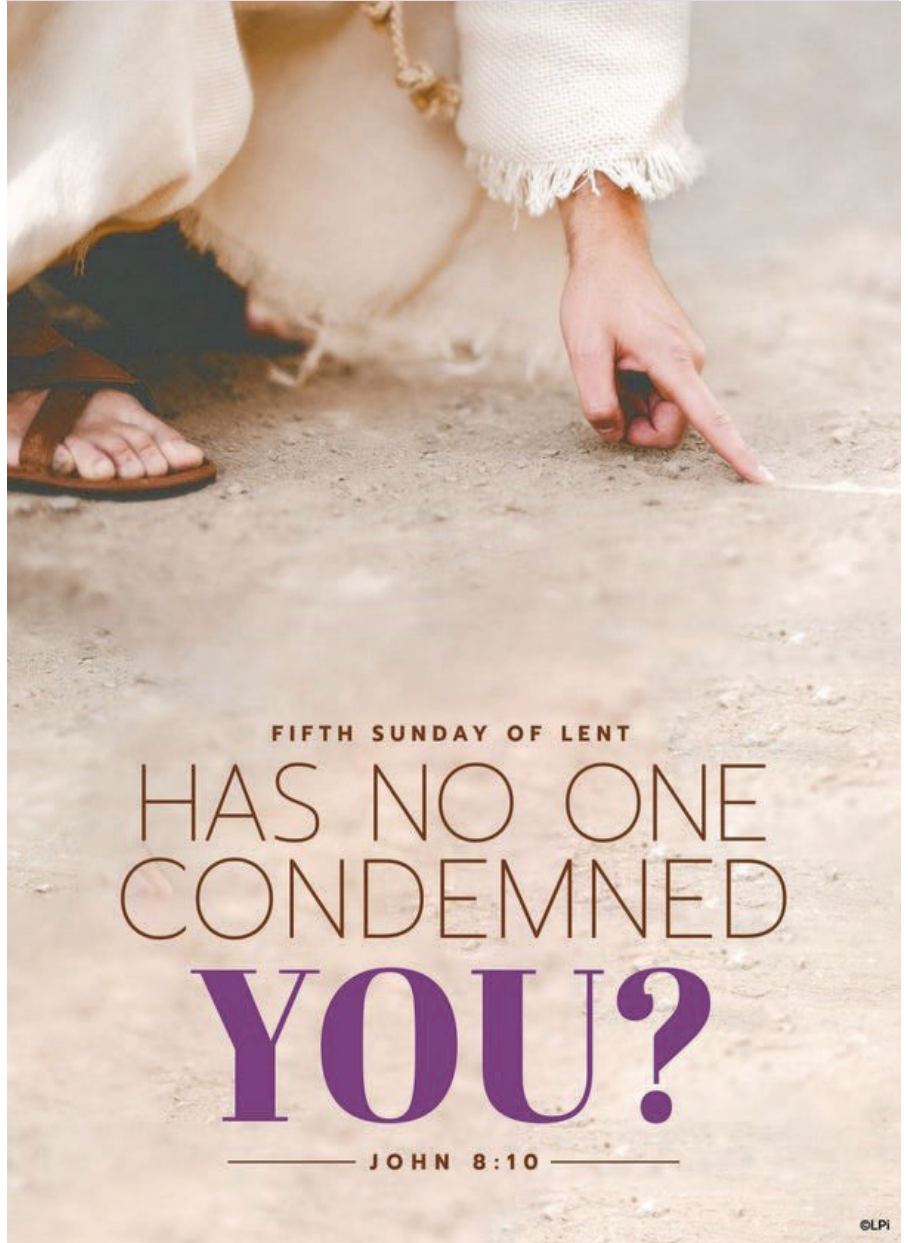

## A MESSAGE FROM FATHER MICHAEL . . .

God's Mercy

God's mercy is truly the greatest of all possible gifts! We are reminded of God's infinite mercy in our readings this weekend. If it weren't for God's mercy, none of us would stand a chance. Mercy provides a fresh start and a cleansing of sin that encourages us to be able to leave sin behind and continue to move forward in goodness and generosity toward God's kingdom.

The prophet Isaiah exhorts God's faithful to not look backwards at the time of exile, but rather embrace God's deliverance. We should always recognize God's intervention in choosing us to be sons and daughters!

The Gospel story of the woman caught in adultery is a dramatic teaching about the depth of God's mercy and the forgiveness that Jesus showed throughout his ministry. It is never too late to seek reconciliation nor is any sin too great for God to pardon! Jesus instructs us to turn away from sin and choose to be faithful to God's ways. The commandments are meant to liberate us and not hinder our relationship with God and one another.

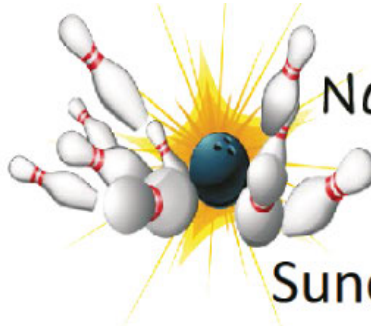
