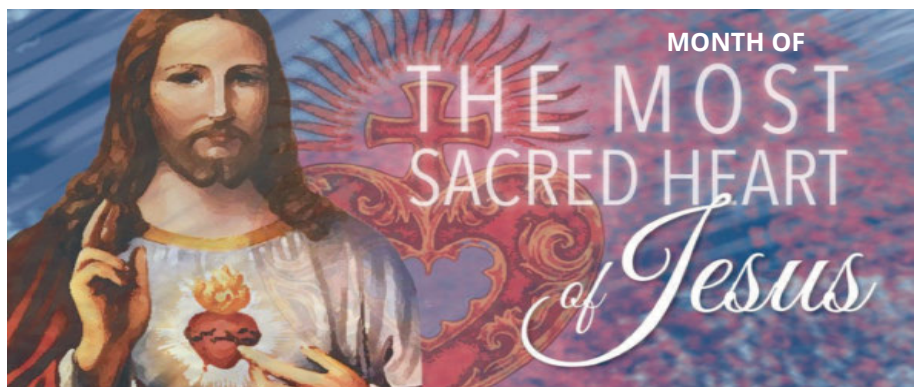
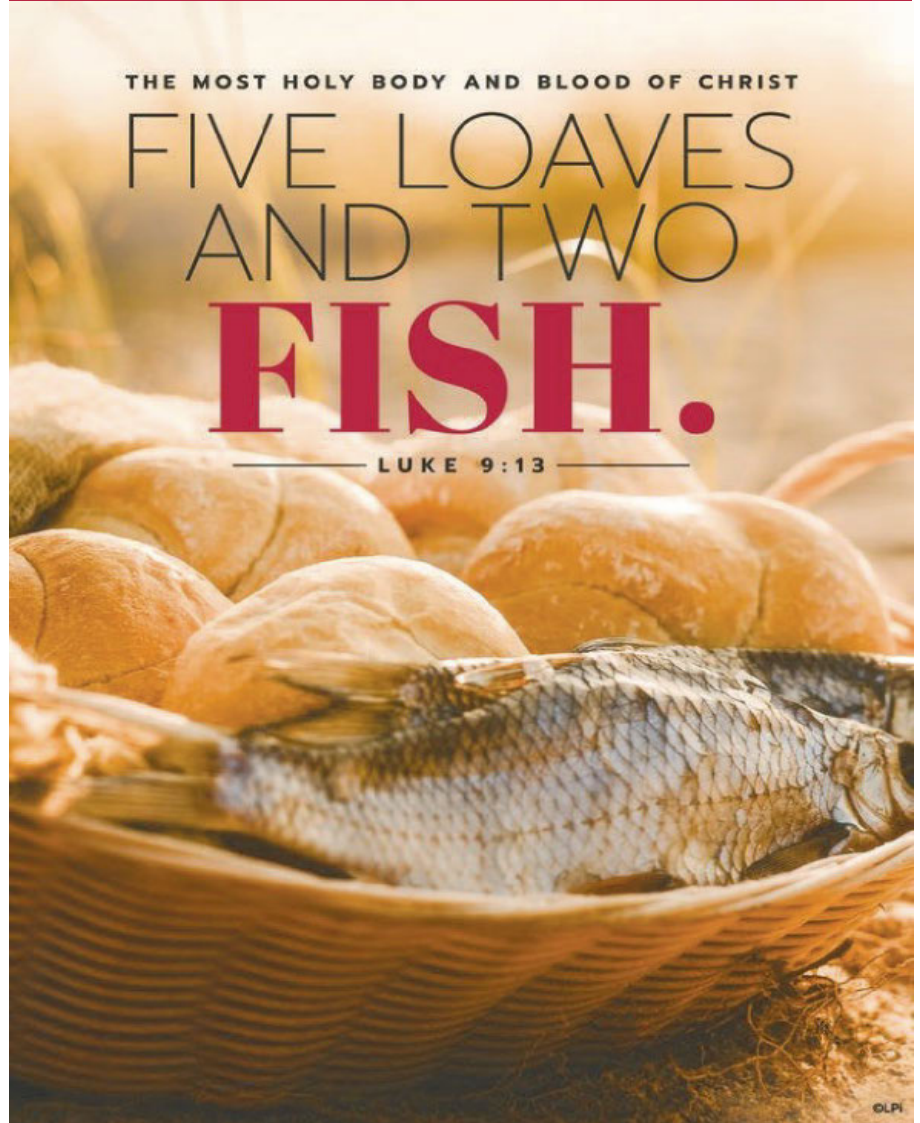

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER MICHAEL . . .

Corpus Christi - The Body and Blood of Christ

This weekend we celebrate Corpus Christi – the very body and blood of Christ that is shed on our behalf and we receive the life-giving presence of Christ! What a gift to celebrate that God would live among us, sacrifice himself for our sins and feed us with his own body and blood so that we might share his life. When we receive this awesome gift, we are reminded of God’s unconditional love for us and that we have truly been incorporated into the family of God. The Eucharist is the divine sacrament that unites us to God and allows the life of God to dwell within us.



The focus of the readings this weekend is hospitality! Melchizedek offers Abram the traditional hospitality of food and drink. During the banquet Melchizedek blesses both God and Abram. That blessing then is returned by praising God and Abram shared one tenth of his wealth with Melchizedek. That is why tithing is a common practice in the Judeo-Christian world. We give back a portion of the blessing that God has bestowed upon us. We can never outdo God in generosity, but we can set aside 10% for God to give to charity and live on 90%. To be generous is to be like God!

The multiplication of the loaves and fishes in the Gospel focuses on the hospitality of Jesus feeding the multitude. The elements for the Eucharistic ritual are contained in this passage from Saint Luke: Jesus took, blessed, broke and gave. That’s what he does for us in the Eucharistic! How blessed are we to partake in this meal and share in God’s life.

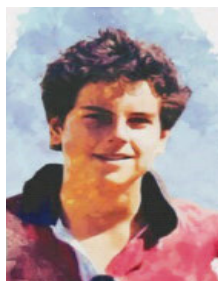
