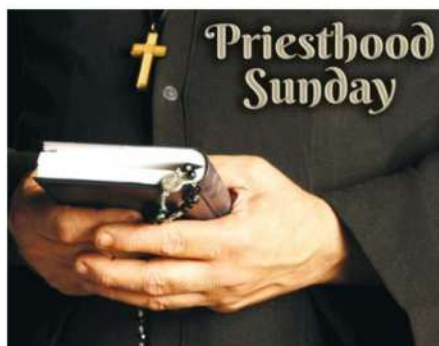

We are also called to be peacemakers – to quiet the hearts of the unruly and bring tranquility to our community. May we always be generous in serving God and neighbor!

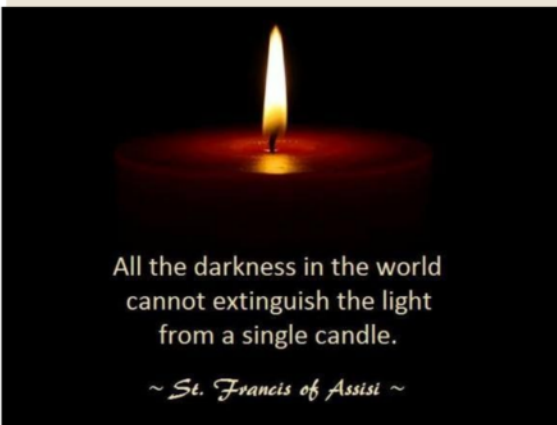

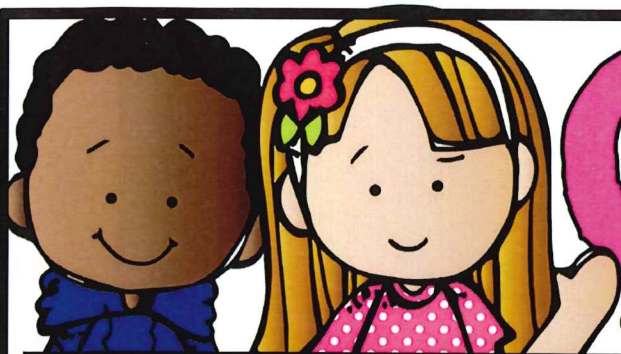
